**School Uniform Price Increases** – We have been informed by our supplier that the cost of new school uniform has increased.

The new prices will be as follows:

Sweatshirts: ages 3-4 to 13 = £9.50 each

Cardigans: ages 3-4 to 13 = £10.80 each

PE Shirts: ages 3-4 to 13 = £7.60

PE Hoodies: ages 5-6 to 12-13 = £15.80 each

Coats: sizes 5-6, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 £21.95 each

REMINDER: Payments for school meals.

Please could we request that parents check their Parentpay accounts and clear any outstanding balances as soon as possible.
