Carol Concert – Cancelled

Unfortunately, we have taken the decision to cancel next Wednesday's carol concert in the church. As per last week's letter, we have seen a rise in COVID cases in school and the community and, in the interests of safety for all involved, felt it best not to hold the concert in person. The children will instead record the songs and readings and these will be available to you either through Google Classroom or the school website before the end of term.

COVID-19 – As stated above, there have been positive cases of COVID-19 in the school community over the past two weeks. Parents are reminded that if their child displays symptoms of coronavirus, they should undergo a PCR test to confirm. Similarly, if a child tests positive on a lateral flow device test, this should be followed up with a PCR test to confirm the result. Current guidance from the Department for Education states that children should only be absent from school due to COVID-19 if they have symptoms and are awaiting test results or have a positive PCR test. As ever, thank you for your cooperation.

The children will be able to see their competition artwork on the light switch on evening from 5.30pm.

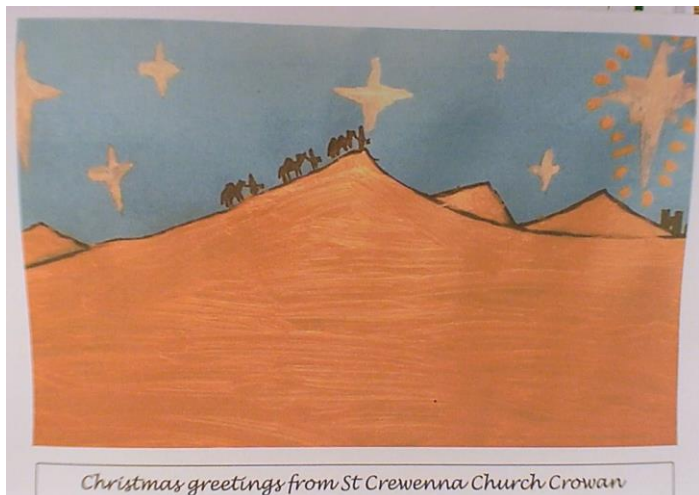
Time2Move – Holiday Activities and Food Programme Christmas 2021

We are pleased to announce that the Time2Move holiday programme, which reached 8,000 children and young

people in Cornwall over the summer holidays, will take place again over the Christmas break.

The Time2Move programme is being delivered by Active Cornwall in partnership with Cornwall Council and is funded by the government [Holiday Activities and Food Programme](#), which funds local authorities to provide FREE holiday club provision, including healthy food and enriching activities, to children eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals.

The Christmas programme is open to all children and young people aged 5 to 16 and activities will mainly take place from Monday 20th to Thursday 23rd December. All children are welcome to attend and it is completely FREE to children on benefits-related Free School Meals.
