End of key Stage SATs Results –

The **Year 6 results** were returned this week. From a small cohort of only 10 children (80% boys and 50% on the SEN Record of Need), the results were as follows:

English – 60% Level 4+ (20% Level 5)

Writing – 70% Level 4+

Reading – 80% Level 4+ (40% Level 5)

Mathematics – 80% Level 4+ (30% Level 5)

The Local Authority target for two levels of progress between key stage 1 and 2 in both English and Maths was 73% and we achieved 80%.

In English 8 of the 10 children made a minimum of 2 levels progress with some making more. (Local Authority target – 82%)

In mathematics, 100% of the children achieved at least the 2 levels progress (Local Authority target – 73%), with one child scoring 96/100 across the 3 papers (Level 5A).

And the Teacher Assessments carried out over a range of work during the year are even better! The children have worked extremely hard and we are very proud of them all.

The Year 2 SATs are all based upon teacher assessment evidence moderated by the Local Authority. From another small cohort of just 8 children (one new entrant at the end of May), the outcomes were as follows:

Writing – 75% Level 2+ (25% Level 3)

Reading – 75% Level 2+ (38% Level 3)

Mathematics – 88% Level 2+ (38% Level 3)

Parent Evenings – Parents with children in the Reception class have the opportunity to discuss their child's progress with Mrs. Northey on Monday, 11th July.

Praze Carnival – We would like to say thank you to all the children who came dressed as characters from 'Little Red Riding Hood' for the carnival last night. We had a lovely time (even dragging the bed up the hill!) and we hope we impressed the crowds lining the street. Thank you also to the parents who helped prepare the children's costumes and face painting for this event.

Praze Fair Show – The children have this week chosen their partners for the children's dance and are very excited about this special occasion in the village calendar. The children should assemble in the playing field in the village at **1.00 pm on Saturday**. The dance will begin at 1.15 pm. from the cricket ground. Please could we ask that the children wear smart, casual clothes and sensible shoes for dancing? They must be collected immediately after the dance from the school staff. Now let's just all cross-fingers for fine weather!

Key Stage 2 Production – Tickets for this year's performances (18th/19th July at 6.00 pm) will cost £1.00 and be available from Monday. Initially only 2 tickets will be available per child but there will be a reserve list. The full dress-rehearsal will now be on Friday afternoon next week for the rest of the school so please could all costumes be ready for then.

Feeder School Concert – Unfortunately, we have been informed by Miss. Judge that the concert due to have been held during the last week of term has now been postponed. Sorry for any inconvenience.

Visits - The Year 5 children went to Camborne S&CC on Thursday morning for a series of science workshops. They were introduced to some very creepy creatures, looked at our solar system inside an inflatable



planetarium and earned their Bunsen burner certificates. Meanwhile, the children in Releath and Trenoweth classes have been introduced to Hindu beliefs and traditions following a visit by Daya. They were able to dress-up in traditional clothes and sample Indian foods too!
